HOLY WEEK SERVICES

This week we follow the events of the last few days in the earthly life of Jesus – his suffering and death, and then his glorious resurrection.

PASSION (PALM) SUNDAY



Today we begin Holy Week with the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem when the people welcomed him as their King and their Messiah – but this king's crown would be thorns, and his throne would be the cross.

Palms are blessed and distributed at each of our

Masses. Masses are at the usual Sunday times.

HOLY WEDNESDAY

On Wednesday the Bishop in St Anthony's church, Wythenshawe will celebrate the Mass of the Chrism. He will bless the oils for use this coming year in our parishes – the Oil of Baptism, the Oil of the Sick, and the Oil of Chrism. Priests renew their priestly promises. It is always a very special Mass.

We will eventually receive our own share of the Oil.

MAUNDY THURSDAY

As the disciples joined Jesus in the Upper Room, so we join together for our fraternal meal – the Mass – when we shall commemorate the Last Supper the night before Jesus died, when the Lord gave us the sacrament of love and unity. The Mass of the Lord's Supper is at 7.00pm in St Patrick's Church. The Mass will be a joint English-Polish celebration, with each of our communities joining together.

GOOD FRIDAY

Friday's Liturgy is absolutely unique – there is nothing quite like it throughout the whole year. The subject that occupies the Church today is the death of her Lord – so it is a sense of mourning that pre-dominates.



Yet the texts of the Service show again and again that the death of Christ is not to be separated from his resurrection. It is viewed against Christ's triumph – it is a *celebration*.

We shall be joined by Fr Denis Maher, a retired priest, who will lead us in the Service.

The Polish Community will gather for their own Solemn Celebration at 6.00pm in St Patrick's Church.

HOLY SATURDAY

The Church, as it were, enters the tomb with the Lord, as it awaits the resurrection. No sacraments are celebrated today. The traditional Polish blessing of food will take place in the morning.

THE EASTER VIGIL


The Lent Services and the Holy Week services prepare us to celebrate the resurrection of the Lord, the greatest feast of the Church. In the Vigil we recall how God formed a people to be his own; how he saved that people not only in the past but even now;



we celebrate our Baptism – how we form that People today. The Lord will again pass among his People: he will come into our hearts and share with us his new, risen life.

This year's Vigil at 7.30pm, will be in St Patrick's Church. The Vigil will be a joint English-Polish language celebration enabling all our different communities to come together to celebrate the resurrection.

EASTER SUNDAY MASSES



Our parish Easter celebrations continue with the other Masses on Easter morning. We renew our Baptismal Promises, and in doing so align ourselves with the Risen Life of Christ.

The morning Masses are at the usual times of 9.00am in Our Lady's Church and 11.00am in St Patrick's. At the 11am Mass we shall Receive Stephen Tidmarsh into the Church.

The Polish Easter Mass is at the usual time of 8:45am in St Patrick's.

GOVERNOR VACANCY AT ST LUKE'S SCHOOL


