

Project Buffalo

Our Lady's Conference has been asked by their Twin Conference in India to assist in the purchase of six buffaloes for needy families. The donation from Our Lady's Conference will be £1020.00, spread over three years.

The buffalo milk can be sold to the milk society in Kottampatti Village and improve the lives of many of these needy families.

Cultivation is a difficult task, and drought has occurred in 60% of the area; people suffer without work. The literacy rate is 10% and 75% of the people live below the poverty line.

Kottampatti is situated in the District of Dharmapuri, Tamil Nadu (State), India. The village is surrounded by small hamlets and the total number of catholics is 700.
